## July Consultation - What you told us

You said the **rural setting** of the town is the best thing about Baldock and that the development of a **country park** is important. You also said that we should leave a gap between Bygrave and the new development.

We have produced a comprehensive green infrastructure strategy which provides a range of green spaces for both people and wildlife with important links to the countryside.

Our strategy integrates the new development into the wider landscape, providing a new Country Park surrounding the development.

Green Links

A series of green links connect the existing town, the proposed development areas and the wider countryside. These will also double as wildlife corridors and areas for recreation for both passive and active uses, such as play areas. The new Schools and Local Centre can all be accessed using the new network of Green Infrastructure along pedestrian pathways.

The housing areas will include a range of play space for different age groups as well as amenity space to further integrate the development into the wider landscape.
